- Ride trained horses in choreographed show scenes with precision, speed, and safety.
- Portray characters in live Wild West-themed performances, including simulated shootouts.
- Handle prop firearms responsibly, following all safety guidelines.
- Maintain a strong and professional stage presence while engaging with guests.
- Participate in rehearsals and follow show scripts, cues, and safety protocols.
- Perform outdoors in all weather conditions—heat, rain, and cold.
- Feed, groom, and care for horses daily.
- Clean stalls, tack, and maintain a clean and organized barn environment.
- Monitor horse behavior and health; report any concerns to Wrangler promptly.
- Support the entertainment and stables team with other duties as needed.
