

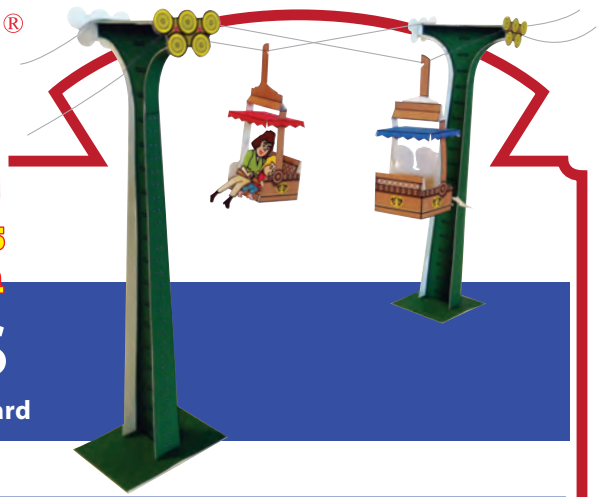

## Chair Lift to Miner's Mountain



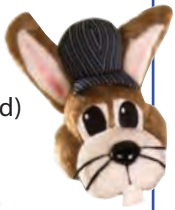
# ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Time to complete: Approx. 75 minutes • Difficulty level: Medium/Hard

## GET STARTED

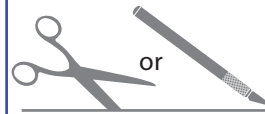
### materials:

- Metal-edged ruler
- Glue (tacky craft glue or rubber cement)
- Butter knife (recommended)
- Scissors or craft knife (have an adult help)
- Spool of thread (any color)



**1.** Print out with a color desktop printer. Use "fit to page" option if needed, and set to maximum print area. Regular copy paper will work, heavier paper like card stock may work better.

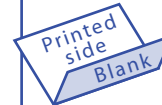
**2.** Use scissors or a craft knife to cut out all the pieces along outer edges and where shown in pink. Have an adult help.



**3.** To help with folding, score all the pieces using the ruler for a guide and run the back side of the butter knife along the corner edges and tabs. Fold back all corners & tabs. (most all fold back to create a "peak" fold)

An example of a "valley" type fold.



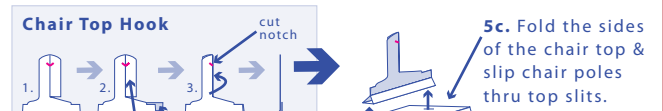
## ASSEMBLY OF YOUR TWEETSIE TOWN, CHAIR LIFT

**4.** After everything is cut, scored & folded, start with the sides of the poles. Follow the directions below for each item, & refer to the final assembled photo. Recommended; print out twice, assemble two poles & two chairs (red & blue tops).

**4a.** Fold the all tabs on pole A & pole B (valley fold). Then glue pole A & B together (printed side out). Be sure **NOT** to glue tabs together.

**4e.** Attach pole pulleys, one on each end as shown.

**5a.** Fold and glue the chair top hook as shown (1, 2, 3).



**5c.** Fold the sides of the chair top & slip chair poles thru top slits.



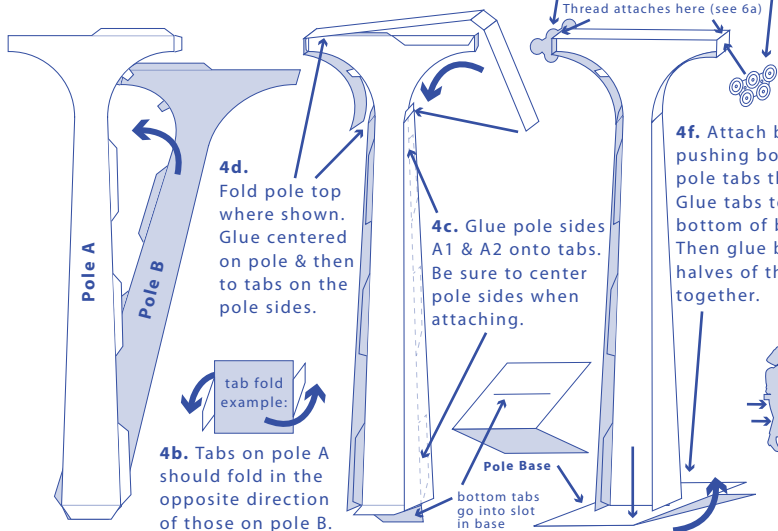
**5b.** Fold and glue the lift chair as shown.

**5d.** Fold the tabs of the chair poles and glue inside the ends of chair top hook.

**5e.** Cut out people and fold at waist & knees where shown. Set in lift chair.



**6a.** Place the two poles at desired distance. Place two lines of thread on poles & then hook chair notch to thread. Add people.



**4d.** Fold pole top where shown. Glue centered on pole & then to tabs on the pole sides.

**4c.** Glue pole sides A1 & A2 onto tabs. Be sure to center pole sides when attaching.

**4f.** Attach base by pushing bottom pole tabs thru slot. Glue tabs to inside bottom of base. Then glue both halves of the base together.



**4b.** Tabs on pole A should fold in the opposite direction of those on pole B.
